## Current Developments

### **E- MONEY**

#### **Inclusion of sQuid e-money on the NEC**

- Pilot scheme to launch in Dundee Nov / Dec 2008**
- Includes Council and retail use**
- 180,000 cards in the Tayside area were eligible during the pilot**
- Initial roll out to 25% of Scottish Council areas**



# NEC Programme

## Current Developments

### HE/FE

**Student matriculation and access to university / college facilities**

- Phase 1 funded by SFC (£100,000) - Completed**
- Phase 2 & 3 bid for roll out across Scotland – funding bid submitted to SFC**
- 293,000 HE Students & 398,000 FE Students (70% Scottish domiciles)**
- Student travel proposals already tabled**
- Incorporates the lifelong learning agenda**

### HE/FE Contd.

#### Project outcomes –

- Adoption of the NEC by Scotland's Colleges and universities
- Joined up lifelong learning services
- Exploitation of pilot outcomes
- Enhanced young persons information network

## Some Current Developments

### **REWARDS / INCENTIVES**

**To apply financial and non-financial levers for behaviour change**

**Through Community Health Partnership**

**Targeting a significant proportion of the population to utilise & change behaviours and reward individuals for making positive choices around their health behaviour.**

**Through Young Scot Active**

**Ensuring that young people are fully engaged and are seen as an asset in delivering the outcomes that Scotland wants.**

**Launched by First Minister at Edinburgh Castle event in October.**

**318,000+ Pupils in secondary schools / 453,500 Age 12 - 18**

## Some Current Developments

### TRANSPORT

NEC encoded to host several ITSO tickets in addition to concessionary travel

Scotland wide roll-out of ITSO certified equipment on buses by End 2009

Commercial ticketing opportunities being pursued include:

- Student travel discounts
- School term passes
- Stored travel rights
- Possible gating (Glasgow underground)
